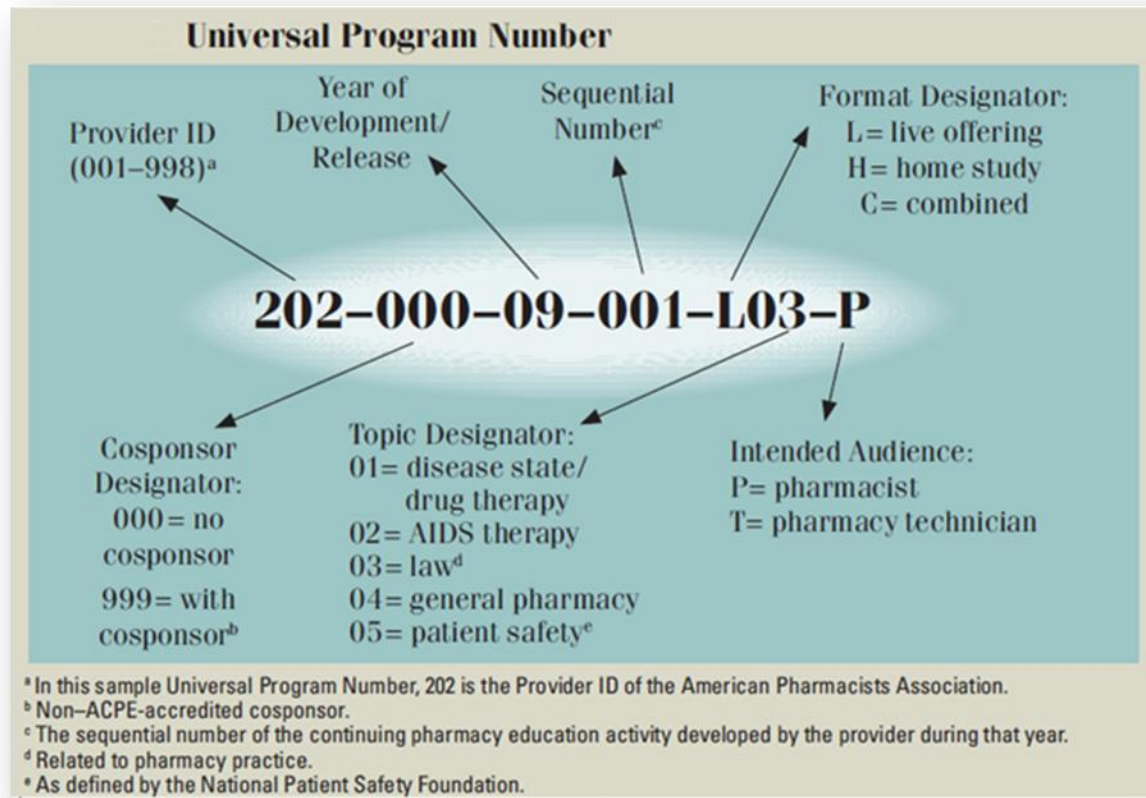


## HOW TO READ CONTINUING EDUCATION CERTIFICATES

It is important for you as a pharmacist or a pharmacy technician to verify licensure requirements with the state boards of pharmacy where you are licensed.



ACPE (Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education) has distinguished three basic CPE (Continuing Professional Education) categories:

1. Knowledge-based activities,
2. Application based activities,
3. Practice-based activities.

Did you know, knowledge-based activities, allows pharmacists and pharmacy technicians to gain knowledge in activities that can be as brief as 15 minutes?

It is important to recognize the Universal Program Numbers (see example above) each reflect the target learning audience, the topic of the program, whether the program was live or home study, etc.

Everything you need to know to determine if a particular program will meet a specific requirement for your license renewal.
